The Planning Commissioners are volunteers who donate many hours of service to the town. Members are appointed by the Mayor, with the advice and consent of the Town Council. A Planning Commission is a body of citizens that serve within local government, acting as an advisory group to the municipal governing body on issues and policies related to planning, land use regulation, and community development.
