The Salt Lake County Urban Wildlife Program is ONLY for the removal of skunks and raccoons in certain areas. It is operated by APHIS U.S. Department of Agriculture. If you have a wild animal issue or need to report an issue, call the hotline listed above. Also, if you need a skunk/raccoon trap, you can call to request one.

APHIS provides education and trapping services, Monday through Friday. They do not trap on weekends.
